# FLAMING ACRES DAHLIAS



## Big Blooms Are on the Horizon at Flaming Acres!

In 2024, we grew 300 dahlia varieties and harvested 3,000 tubers for replanting. This year, we've planted 4,000 tubers — and we're just getting started.

A heartfelt thank you to Jim Lamson of Ontario, Oregon, a legendary dahlia grower and hybridizer for over 60 years, who generously shared some of his finest varieties with us. His dahlias will be blooming right alongside ours in what promises to be a dazzling display.

Come Fall, we're expecting a bumper tuber harvest, which means online tuber sales will begin in September/October 2025 (Shipping will happen in Spring 2026, once tubers awaken from winter dormancy.)

And then... the big reveal.

**Labor Day Weekend 2026:** over 30,000 dahlias in bloom! Join us for our all-new 1st Annual Flower Festival featuring our reopened coffee shop, fresh flowers, live music, workshops, art, and more.

🌸 Please note: Our future is blooming with dahlias — and we'll no longer be hosting Fall Harvest Festival Days. Thank you for three amazing seasons. Your support has been everything. We can't wait to welcome you back in 2026 for a season of flowers, friends, and fresh beginnings.

Here's Dion in action, carefully dividing dahlia clumps into individual tubers...on average, each clump yielded about 10 tubers, all destined for a long winter's nap.

Last year, we tucked them into a cool, dark room in our basement (think spa retreat for sleepy dahlias). But with our 2025 crop expected to be much bigger, we're going big too — building a proper root cellar, much like those used for storing potatoes, to keep our tubers cozy, dormant, and ready for spring planting.

Because when you're growing thousands of dahlias, even the storage gets an upgrade!



# GROWING FORWARD



In May, we brought our dahlia tubers out of their winter slumber and into the sunshine. Over 4,000 tubers were planted by hand in our fields — a true labor of love! We expect the first blooms to begin dazzling us by late August, with peak bloom season following shortly after.

By September we'll have a better idea of how many tubers of each variety we can offer — and that's when our online store will open for business at [flamingacresdahlias.com](http://flamingacresdahlias.com)
